"Climate Change and Mangroves-Kachchh Context"

Gujarat Institute of Desert Ecology (GUIDE), Bhuj was implementing an IUCN-MFF funded project with an aim to develop a model involving coastal industries and mangrove dependant coastal communities for successful mangrove conservation and restoration in Kachchh district. Inculcating awareness and generating capacity among coastal industries on climate change and carbon economics potential of enhanced mangrove cover was an important component in this ongoing project.
